



## CardioInsight Technologies Inc. strikes deal with Japanese distributor

CardioInsight Technologies Inc. has struck a deal with a Japanese distributor that will invest in the Cleveland-based company and work to commercialize its medical imaging technology in Japan.

In addition to the deal with the distributor, DVx of Tokyo, CardioInsight announced that it plans to launch its EC Mapping system in Europe in June, with a U.S. launch to follow later this year.

The system uses an electrode vest placed on the patient's body to gather electrical information about the heart. It combines that information with images from a CT scan to provide 3D maps of electrical activity in the heart. The technology has been tested on more than 260 patients with heart problems.

The company in early 2010 raised \$6 million from Draper Triangle Ventures of Pittsburgh, Case Technology Ventures, an electrophysiologist and company management.
